As a [GOLD/SILVER/BRONZE] Partner, you and your colleagues can access a number of benefits. Below outlines how you can access these and what to expect out of your Corporate Partnership.

Networking Events

You will receive exclusive invitations to Networking Events with other Corporate Partners and Circle Level Members of our Individual Members Scheme. We aim to deliver a minimum of four events a year that offer opportunities for you to meet and network with others in the scheme.

Gold and Silver members will be invited to exclusive backstage opportunities and access events for you and your staff.

Guest Nights

As part of your Corporate Partnership Scheme membership, you will receive invitations to our VIP Guest Nights here at Theatre Royal Wakefield. Guest Nights take place on all Theatre Royal Wakefield produced shows: Pantomime, Wakefield Youth Music Theatre productions and John Godber productions*.

Each Corporate Partner is entitled to two tickets for the Guest Night performance, a programme and drinks vouchers for the after show drinks. These events are a great opportunity to network with other Corporate Partners, Sponsors and Circle Level Members. These tickets are only transferable to another suitable staff member who can make use of the networking opportunities, please contact Sarah is these tickets need to be transferred.

Two to three weeks before the performance, you will be emailed with a link that allows you to choose your seats and book your tickets. However, dates will be advertised in advance through the Corporate Newsletter. When you arrive, come and say hi to the Development Team, who will be located in the foyer area, so we can give you our programme and after show drinks vouchers. Don't forget to join us after the show for a drink and a chat, where possible we invite the cast to join us.

Corporate Newsletter

Another benefit of is the Corporate Newsletter that is distributed monthly. This is an e-newsletter and will keep you up to date with what is going on at the Theatre, updates on what your support is funding, as well as updates and offers from other Corporate Partners.

Company Logos

Your company logo will be featured on the screens in the Theatre foyer, Café Bar and Dress Circle Bar. Also appearing on Theatre Royal Wakefield's Corporate Partners webpage, in the season brochure and Theatre Royal Wakefield production programmes. It will also appear in the company logo in programmes for John Godber Company productions with work touring nationally*.

Booking Tickets and Priority Booking

One of the benefits of your Corporate Partnership is complimentary tickets; you are welcome to use these tickets for yourself, colleagues or customers, or any other way you see fit. We are always happy to share any promotions or offers you run, to give away any of these tickets.

Gold and Silver Members will be contacted by email 10 days before each new season goes on sale or when a show goes on sale mid-season. During this time, you will be able to book tickets on a first come first served basis for all shows.

Bronze Members will be contacted by email the day before tickets on general sale, again tickets are sold/allocated on a first come first serve basis. Only people you have authorised will be able to book tickets and only the main contact will be able update this.

In our Matcham Auditorium, we have 10 seats in the Dress Circle (C10 – C19) which are our designated Private Property Seats. These are the best seats in the house and therefore allocated to you, our wonderful Corporate Partners. You can book these seats as part of your ticket allocation.

As there are only 10 seats available for our Corporate Partners for each performance, it is important that you book them where possible in the priority-booking widow. Tickets can be booked outside this priority-booking window but we cannot always guarantee availability. We will try wherever possible to fulfil\ your request. You will be capped at two tickets per performance, but of course, you are welcome to purchase the extra tickets!

If you need accessible seats please speak to us and we will do our best to accommodate your request and move you to a more suitable part of the auditorium.

For Pantomime, Wakefield Youth Music Theatre productions and John Godber productions* there is greater flexibly for the number and location of your seats and the above restriction does not apply. We are able to do large group bookings for these shows, you can also speak to us about wrap around opportunities such as drinks vouchers, programmes, ice creams and room hire for staff parties.

Occasionally, for very high demand shows we are unable to offer any complimentary tickets, but will ensure you get the opportunity to purchase tickets in the priority-booking window.

Gold Members will also get access to ticket offers for you and your staff, which will be emailed to your main contact to allow you to share across your staff team.

Additional Silver and Gold benefits

Any bespoke or additional benefits that have been agreed will be outlined on your agreement. You will have the opportunity to speak to Sarah about how these are delivered.
