

Letter for schools re. students taking part in 2021 pantomime

For the Attention of the Welfare Officer/Head of Year/Class Teacher for Academic Year 2021/2022
We are writing to you because one of your pupils () would like to attend the audition for Theatre Royal Wakefield's pantomime Beauty and the Beast on Sunday 19 th September. Before they sign up to audition we want to ensure schools have a bit more information and are happy to give an in principal agreement as we know schools have been greatly impacted by Covid and, if the pupil is successful at audition they would need to be granted some time off school. We have asked parents to show this letter to you before signing up for the audition to avoid any disappointment later on.
If successful at audition your pupil will join one of three chorus teams sharing 84 performances in November and December 2021, with a combined audience of over 29,000. It is a big commitment but, after such a difficult 18 months, we think this is an exciting opportunity for young performers.
We believe those who take part in our pantomime benefit greatly from the experience. They will rehearse and perform with a professional creative team, technical team and cast and have the chance to learn a lot from the collective experience of the company.
We expect each team to have 4 or 5 rehearsals and 10 or 11 performances during school time between 11th November and 17th December.
